AMH, on behalf of its partner Mother of Mercy Hospital, Gidel, Nuba Mountains, Sudan, seeks a qualified and experienced accountant to serve as Finance Manager of the hospital according to the attached JD.

The qualified candidate will be a qualified accountant with a bachelor's degree and will have completed at least one part of an East Africa accountancy exam equivalent to CPA-K. He/she will have a minimum five years' experience preparing general ledgers and financial statements for a medium- to large-sized organization. Healthcare experience is a plus.

The chosen candidate will help establish and improve hospital financial systems, including setting up Quickbooks and preparing regular financial statements. He/she will work with and train local staff. The candidate should be able and willing to work in a cross-cultural context with sensitivity and respect.

This position is focused on capacity-building. The contract will be a one-year renewable consultancy with African Mission Healthcare depending on performance and hospital need. A target consultancy of 2-3 years is planned. Competitive compensation and benefits are offered.

With a ceasefire in place and an improvement in the political situation, the hospital board and partners wish to establish a comprehensive financial system.

JOB DESCRIPTION: Finance Manager, Gidel Hospital, Nuba Mountains, Sudan

Reports to: Hospital Administrator

Coordinates with: Hospital Management Team, cashier and finance staff, hospital donors

Duties

- A. The finance manager is responsible for overall management of the financial systems of the hospital. The primary task of the hospital finance manager is to establish a comprehensive hospital-wide financial reporting system capable of informing decision-making by leadership and ensuring accountability of resources.
- B. Set up QuickBooks financial system.
- C. Establish the hospital chart of accounts and cost centers mapping.
- D. Prepare general ledger and financial statements monthly, that include income and expenditure, balance sheet and cash-flow statements.
- E. Establish payroll and project accounting.
- F. Track petty cash and ensure security of resources.
- G. Track local and donor revenue and utilization, including local equivalent of in-kind donations.
- H. Establish an asset register.
- I. Write a comprehensive financial policy governing the above systems.
- J. Serve as a member of the hospital management team. Provide monthly financial statements to the Hospital Management Team(HMT) and quarterly statements to the Board of Trustees and major donors.
- K. Mentor and train local staff in the above procedures and systems.

Requirements:

1. Bachelor's degree or higher in accounting (Bcom Accounting or Finance)
2. Minimum 5 years' experience (preferably 7 or greater) experience working as an accountant in a medium- to large-size organization preparing a general ledger and financial statements.
3. Minimum Part 1 qualification toward CPA-K or national equivalent.

5. Solid quantitative and communication skills.
6. Willingness to work in a cross-cultural environment and train local staff.
